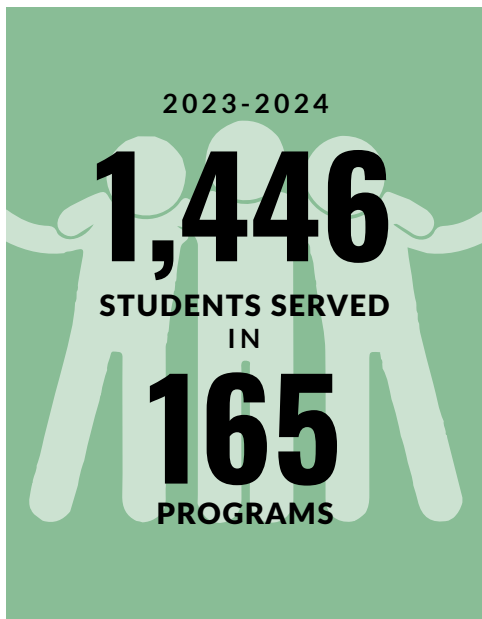

Qualities of Successful Programs:

When considering funding for programs, coordinators and board members will be considering the following elements:

- Energetic, understanding, consistent program leaders.
- Program staff who are frequently at sites to develop relationships with students. This helps with recruitment as well as attendance.
- Robust and enriching programming that is age-appropriate and of interest to students.
- Flexibility of schedules to allow for school sites to prioritize instructional time.
- Participate in signature SEL practices including warm welcomes, engaging activities, and optimistic closures.
- Completes daily attendance and all requirements for TIDEL data entry.
- Participates in all safety requirements outlined by the school and district.
